G2 Kunsthalle & Hildebrand Collection

Selected art works from the Hildebrand Collection are permanently on view at G2 Kunsthalle. The private collection focuses on contemporary painting from Leipzig, represented through significant art works by established artists as well as by younger, emerging names. A second substantial nucleus of the collection consists of national and international artistic movements. Founded in March 2015, the G2 Kunsthalle and its more than 1,000 square meters exhibition space are located in the 3rd floor of the former GDR processing centre in the city centre of Leipzig.

The permanent presentation of the collection includes art works by Hans Aichinger, Judith Bernstein, Henriette Grahnert, Paule Hammer, Melissa Gordon, Katrin Heichel, Uwe Kowski, Rosa Loy, Raymond Pettibon, Jochen Plogsties, Neo Rauch, Daniel Richter, Christoph Ruckhäberle, Tomás Saraceno, David Schnell, Kristina Schuldt, Ruprecht von Kaufmann, Matthias Weischer and many other artists.

Parallel to the exhibition of the collection, G2 Kunsthalle realizes special exhibitions in collaboration with contemporary artists. The project following **COLORS OF DESCENTS** by Tobias Hild, Julius Hofmann and Robert Seidel will be dedicated to Leipzig painter Peter Krauskopf and his abstract compositions. It will be Krauskopf's first institutional show in his birth city Leipzig.
